WOOLWORTHS NETSETGO

They're young, they're small, and they've got energy to burn. It's time to play netball with Woolworths NetSetGO.

Woolworths NetSetGO is Australia's official starter program for girls and boys aged 5 to 10. It's a chance to learn the netball basics, get outside and make some friends. For a lot of kids, this is the first time they'll pick up a netball or chuck on a bib. It's a learning experience. And a lot of fun.



WHY KIDS LOVE WOOLWORTHS NETSETGO

We spoke with kids about their experience in Woolworths NetSetGO and it became apparent that we are hitting a "sweet spot" with a good balance of socialisation and providing an environment to have-a-go. Play

This is about the sense of belonging...I belong here with my friends and on this team. It is about social fit, connection with others and the ability to play at the level required. This is an opportunity for us, to not just harness the connections for kids, but also for parents and the netball community



Dream

This is about the game – the competition – and this is where things like role models and aspiration exists. In our little Net kids, this can show up as a connection with the coach or other older kids who help out. For our GO kids, this can be things like aspiring to play at the next level, to have an official role like coach or umpire or maybe to win.

THE IMPORTANCE OF MODIFIED SPORT

Woolworths NetSetGO pride ourselves on developing an inclusive, fun and extraordinary program and we have a few key philosophies to help us do this:

Modified equipment and rules increase moments of success, sense of achievement and help develop skills safely.

Why are modified rules and equipment used in Woolworths NetSetGO?

It's important to remember that kids aren't just small adults. Their bodies are still developing, and we don't want to make things too difficult at this early age. We want them to enjoy what they are doing so they stay active for longer.

The rules and equipment have been modified to be developmentally suitable for kids, which is underpinned by scientific research and evidence.

The use of modified rules and equipment reduces competitive stress, allowing children more time and space to practice and develop skills. This increases the opportunity to make friends, learn social skills and most importantly have FUN!

LEVELS OF PROGRESSION (TIERS)

To help kids navigate through the netball part of the program, Woolworths NetSetGO has added three levels (or tiers) of progression. These tiers will help coaches run age and skill level appropriate activities for their kids, maximising their engagement in the program. Please note that progression through the tiers is based predominantly on the skill level and changing needs of the participants (i.e. not restricted by age ranges).

PLAYING POSITIONS



GS - Goal Shooter

Scoring goals is the main aim of the game for the GS. They are only allowed into the attacking third.

GA - Goal Attack

The GA sneaks into all sorts of pockets of space in the centre and attacking thirds of the court.

WA - Wing Attack

The WA is the little helper every shooter needs. They are allowed into the centre and attacking thirds, but cannot go into the goal circle.

GK - Goal Keeper

The GK is the very last line of defence on the netball court.

GD - Goal Defense

GD works together with the GK to stop the GA and GS from shooting goals in the goal circle.

WD - Wing Defense

The WD goes where the WA goes " in the centre and defensive thirds of the court.

C - Centre

This speedy all-rounder moves everywhere on court except the shooting circles.

Woolworths NetSetGO coaches encourage all participants to have a go at each position. Understanding each position is vital to comprehending the fundamentals of netball. Please visit the Woolworths NetSetGO Playground if you would like to learn more.

PARTICIPANT PACKS

Once the registration has been processed, participants will receive a separate e-store activation email. After the account has been activated, store credit will automatically be applied to their account. The participant will need to redeem the FREE participant pack and process the order.

The participant pack includes a t-shirt and a NetSetGO size 4 netball and participants will have the option to personalise the top with their name for an additional \$10. The pack will take between 3-10 business days to arrive at the participants nominated address.

If your Woolworths NetSetGO t-shirt doesn't fit, we are happy for you to exchange it. You will need to send your existing t-shirt with an exchange form back to our warehouse in Rowville, Victoria. Please contact our customer service team who will help you exchange your t-shirt for a new size. The cost of returning the existing t-shirt lies with the customer.

The Netball Australia fee will NOT be refunded once the pack has been processed. Refund or withdrawals relating to the other fee components are dealt with by the Member Organisations according to each entities refund policy. Please get in touch with your Member Organisation to find out more.

FAQS

What should my child bring to their Woolworths NetSetGO session?

We recommend that your child wears their Woolworths NetSetGO t-shirt with either shorts, a skirt and whatever they feel most comfortable in. Make sure they bring along their netball, drink bottle and don't forget their hat (if they're playing outside).

My child hasn't received their pack and the program starts this week. Can they still attend?

Yes, of course! If your child hasn't received their pack just make sure they wear something that they can move around in. If the pack doesn't arrive within 10 business days from the date of order, please get in contact with the NetSetGO shop <u>here.</u>

I registered my child to Woolworths NetSetGO and haven't received any additional information regarding time, date, etc. Who do I need to contact?

Please get in contact with the NetSetGO coordinator at your Centre and they will be able to provide you with the program details.

My child has never played netball before. Is that a problem?

Not at all. Woolworths NetSetGO is perfect for beginners, and has been designed to suit every child not matter of their ability or experience.

What tier should my child be in?

Tiers are based on a range of factors including skill ability and needs of the participant. We always recommend chatting to your NetSetGO coordinator to ensure your child is in the right tier.
